Easy Problems

Three boxes. Each box contains 240 marbles. How many in all?

Five baskets. Each basket contains 345 oranges. How many oranges in all?

Harold is organizing his trading cards. He has put all of his cards into albums. He has seven albums. Each album contains 164 cards. How many cards in all?

Medium Problems

Elisabeth brought 5 boxes of books. Three boxes had 75 books each. The other two boxes each contained 125 books each. How many books altogether?

Gail has 7 baskets. Four boxes have 34 plums each. Three boxes have 225 apricots each. How many pieces of fruit altogether?

Hard Problem

Tom sold roses for \$12.75 a bunch. He sold 12 bunches on Monday, 15 bunches on Tuesday, and 22 bunches on Wednesday. How much money did he make?

Hardest Problem

Every day in April, Bill made \$120.50. How much did he earn for the entire month?
